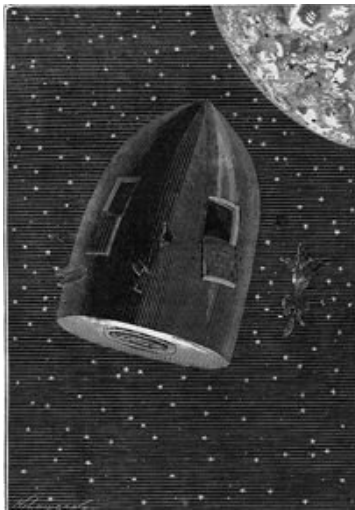


WORKSHOP

- collect ideas about possible initiatives at European level to support the community of actors involved in space and education.

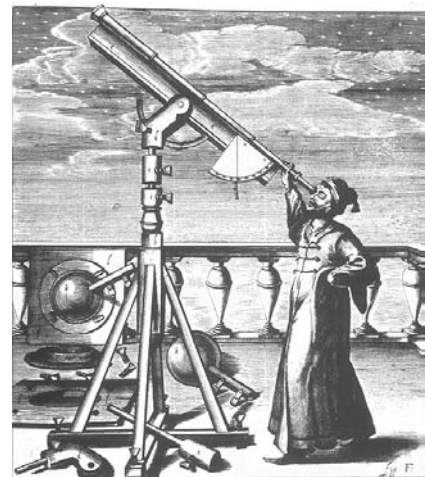
